Introduction to the Worship Team

We love to be together as a community for our regular Gatherings. To help facilitate the Gatherings we have a variety of Teams that work together to create a space for people to meet with God and to build relationship with one another.

As part of the worship team, your role would be to help lead the City on a Hill congregation in corporate worship as a vocalist or instrumentalist under the direction of the Worship Leader.

What are the key responsibilities of the Worship Team Members?

- Model worship for the congregation through your attitudes and actions.
- Demonstrate competence instrumentally and/or vocally and strive to play your instrument to your greatest potential for the Lord (Col 3:23).
- Attend scheduled rehearsals and church gatherings punctually.
- Commit to being on a worship team and a worship rota (serving just once a month, or more if you would like to).
- Engage with team training and meetings.
- Be aware of your assigned role for the worship team that week and prepare in advance by practicing and preparation of the songs.
- Provide feedback to the Worship Team Leaders for continued growth and improvement.
- Each time you serve, the set list, lyrics, music etc. will be sent out to the team with the Worship Leader assigning specific roles (who will lead each song etc.).
- Pray into the worship and for the church in the lead up to the week you are serving.

Some specific requirements for Worship Team Members

- Be a member of City on a Hill (complete the Foundations Course followed by a chat with your community Pastor) and regularly attend services whether you are or are not serving in the worship team on any given Sunday.
- Participate in an audition for the team.
- Must be a team player and willing to receive feedback.
- Willing to be involved in a Small Group.
- Be available for practice outside of a Sunday gathering (varies for each community).
